We have reached out to the floor vendor and the vendor that will address the kitchen equipment for the Pub kitchen floor project. Our floor vendor informs us there is a nation-wide shortage on the raw materials needed to handle the project. This will likely delay the project, so we might be looking at a mid-July completion.
