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Engineering:

The small fountain pump is down. I'm afraid we are going to continue to go through pumps until we get VFD (variable frequency drives) or soft start components installed on these systems. Theses are 15 HP pumps that require sudden jolts to their components to start them. Because of this action happening everyday, the pumps are wearing down. VFDs will help solve these issues as well lengthen the life of our pumps and lower our energy costs. I am working with our vendor to find the right solution.

Fire pit top replacement has been pushed to Monday June 15th. As well the glass wind shield is on order and should arrive and be installed late next week.

Elevator door suddenly stopped working this week. Vendor was out and repaired a broken belt.

Hubert has been working on repairing damaged thresholds at various entrance.

The new umbrella stands have been assembled and most all of our new tables have umbrellas installed.




Maintenance team was able to get cobwebs and bug nests removed from the tiki ceiling

We are unfortunately still waiting on the hip printers, however once they arrive we will be able to start using them

Chef has been working diligently with Pulp software to get our new inventory program up and running. Next week we should be going live with orders and deliveries being logged through the system.

Chef and I have been going through the kitchen reserve items scheduled for this year and have been identifying what is in poor condition. We are currently looking as his fryer and grill for the pub kitchen.

Chef and I are continuing to explore melamine options for the tiki bar. My desire is to go full melamine for all dinning at tiki and disposable for pool side. This would mean roll ups and silverware to be used at the tiki as well. So far we haven't found a good product, some additional samples will be arriving over the next couple of weeks.

lpads are just about operational. Printers are supposedly in route and will be installed in the next week.

Our new credit card processing merchant went live a couple of weeks ago. There will be some savings for us via lower % rates on the transaction fees.

We are working on finalizing the kitchen, card room, bar, and ice cream area flooring replacement project. Working on the right time to get this accomplished.

Chef and I will be looking at some melamine options for tiki. Hope to have a proposal in the next couple of weeks.
