ABC electric is out this week working on repairing the large water fall lights. We believe there is an issue in one of the junction boxes.

There was a gas leak for the fire pit. The vendor was out and made repairs. The leak was located at a fitting near the timer.

Elevator remains down. We have replaced a blown hydraulic pump and starter, but still can't seem to keep the elevator running without it shutting down. To top it off they incorrectly billed us for labor pertaining to the pump install, despite the fact the quote included labor. The previous issues were real, we aren't questioning that. However, something remains an issue.

After several delays and a change of vendors the card room floor is finally done! The flooring came out great and really looks sharp. We plan to do the same thing for the pub kitchen floor, but that will be later down the road.



The waterline break near the kiddie splash pad is finally repaired. There was not one but two cracks located in the 2 inch line. Both are repaired, the hole backfilled, and pavers replaced.

I was just getting ready to say the elevator is finally back up and running, however it seems to have gone down again. We have had multiple issues at the same time, both the hydraulic pump and various relays had failed. We believe there is a solenoid issue, but the vendor has not been able to completely solve the issue.

F&B:

As well we know it would be tough to fill this position with the right person in the middle of season.
